

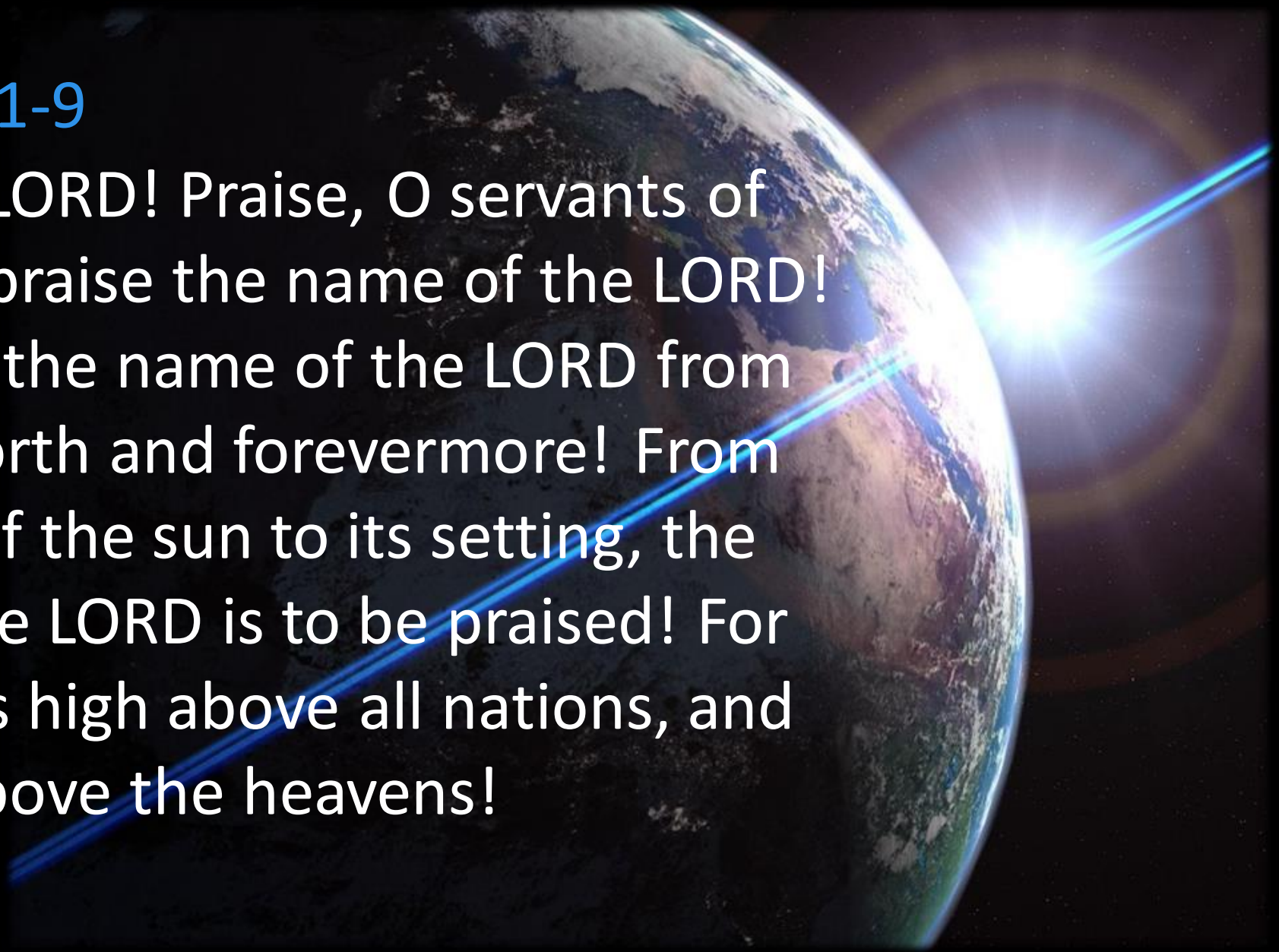


# Lord of Heaven & Earth

Psalms 40:1-3
