The highway to discipleship

John 14

1 "Let not your hearts be troubled; believe in God, believe also in me.² In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?³ And when I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.⁴ And you know the way where I am going."⁵ Thomas said, "Master, we have no idea where you're going. How do you expect us to know the road?"⁶ Jesus said, "I am the Road, also the Truth, also the Life. No one gets to the Father apart from me.⁷ If you really knew me, you would know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him. You've even seen him!"⁸ Philip said, "Master, show us the Father; then we'll be content."⁹ "You've been with me all this time, Philip, and you still don't understand? To see me is to see the Father. So how can you ask, 'Where is the Father?'"

Luke 24

13 That very day two of them were going to a village named Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, ¹⁴ and talking with each other about all these things that had happened.¹⁵ While they were talking and discussing together, Jesus himself drew near and went with them.

Luke 18

35 Then it happened, as He was coming near Jericho, that a certain blind man sat by the road begging.³⁶ And hearing a multitude passing by, he asked what it meant.³⁷ So they told him that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by.³⁸ And he cried out, saying, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

39 Then those who went before warned him that he should be quiet; but he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"⁴⁰ So Jesus stood still and commanded him to be brought to Him. And when he had come near, He asked him,⁴¹ saying, "What do you want Me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, that I may receive my sight."⁴² Then Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has made you well."
