Psalm 95:1-2

¹ Oh come, let us sing to the LORD! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation. ² Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms.

Psalm 100:4

Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.

A: for who He is

Psalm 107:1

Oh give thanks to the LORD, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.

B: for what He has done

Psalm 107:2-3

² Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy, ³ And gathered out of the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south.

B1: when you were lost

Psalm 107:4, 7

⁴ They wandered in the wilderness in a desolate way; They found no city to dwell in.

⁷ And He led them forth by the right way, That they might go to a city for a dwelling place.

B2: when you were bound

Psalm 107:10, 14

¹⁰ Those who sat in darkness and in the shadow of death, Bound in affliction and irons—

¹⁴ He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, And broke their chains in pieces.

B3: when you were afflicted

Psalm 107:17, 20

¹⁷ Fools, because of their transgression, And because of their iniquities, were afflicted.

²⁰ He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions.

B4: when you are in a storm

Psalm 107:23, 29

²³ Those who go down to the sea in ships, Who do business on great waters,

²⁹ He calms the storm, So that its waves are still.

C: for what He will always do

Psalm 107:35-38

³⁵ He turns a wilderness into pools of water, and dry land into watersprings. ³⁶ There He makes the hungry dwell, that they may establish a city for habitation, ³⁷ And sow fields and plant vineyards, that they may yield a fruitful harvest. ³⁸ He also blesses them, and they multiply greatly; and He does not let their cattle decrease.
