





**a life without Christ**


**fullness of joy**

**john 15:11**




**how do we lose our joy?**

3. Circumstances.


**how do we restore and maintain our joy?**




**1. the joy of His presence**

**psalm 16:11**




**2. the joy of His faithfulness**

**habakkuk 3:17-18**




**3. the joy of giving**
