false flag definition:

It describes covert operations that are designed to deceive in such a way that the operations appear as though they are being carried out by entities, groups or nations other than those who actually planned and executed them.

false flag definition:

Operations carried out during peacetime by civilian organizations, as well as covert government agencies, may (by extension) be called false flag operations if they seek to hide the real organization behind an operation.

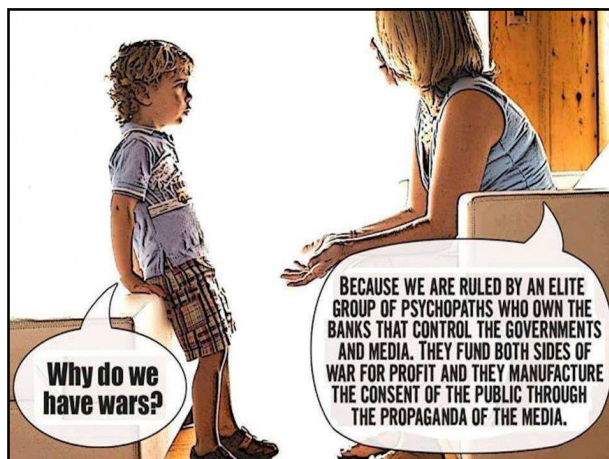

The Narrative - definitions :

Narrative meaning is created by establishing that something is a part of a whole and usually that something is the cause of something else.
