- <sup>18</sup> And they withstood King Uzziah, and said to him, "It is not for you, Uzziah, to burn incense to the LORD, but for 2 Chronicles 26:16-21 (NKJV)

the priests, the sons of Aaron, who are consecrated to burn incense. Get out of the sanctuary, for you have trespassed! You shall have no honor from the LORD God."

<sup>19</sup> Then Uzziah became furious; and he had a censer in his hand to burn incense. And while he was angry with the priests, leprosy broke out on his forehead, before the priests in the house of the LORD, beside the incense altar.
<sup>20</sup> And Azariah the chief priest and all the priests looked at 2 Chronicles 26:16-21 (NKJV)

him, and there, on his forehead, he was leprous; so they thrust him out of that place. Indeed he also hurried to get out, because the LORD had struck him.

 $^{21}$  King Uzziah was a leper until the day of his death. He dwelt in an isolated house, because he was a leper; for he was cut off from the house of the LORD. Then Jotham his son was over the king's house, judging the people of the land.

#### Four areas of pride

- 1. Spiritual pride: gifts, calling, authority, etc.
- 2. Cultural pride: language, family, school, etc.
- 3. Material pride: riches, possessions, appearance, etc.
- 4. Pride of success: qualification, title, career, etc.
