Stand (ἰστώνω)

I make to stand, I set up: I weigh (pay), Mt. 26:15; (b) I am set up, I am made to stand, I stand, I take an erect position, I stand firm: = ἀντιστήναι, Eph. 6:13.

When we stand:

- We stand in our position in Christ (no openings)
- We stand for those around us
- We stand for those who can't now
