















Christ- the truth manifested (divine personality)

Word – The truth that Sanctifies (washes away lies about the real Christ)

Spirit – The truth that Witnesses (in our spirits about the real Christ)









Matthew 18:15-16 (NIV)

"If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. But if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses..

2 Timothy 2:24–26 (NKJV)

And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will.





- Truth is absent because of sin, rebellion and deception
- Truth is Jesus, His Word and His Spirit
- The church (His House) is the primary means by which truth gets proclaimed and manifested to the world!
- Truth brings forth repentance from sin and disobedience
- True family restore one another by bringing gentle correction – not eternal judgement
- True Freedom is freedom from sin and the resultant bondage /death

Weekly small group notes from Sunday Sermon (SG duration - 1 to 1.5hrs)

- 1. Welcome: Introduce SG to visitors and ask group to share on the following- In popular culture around us what would people say is "ultimate truth"?
- 2. Worship together: 1 or 2 Worship Songs and open SG in prayer asking the father to reveal to us what is truth?
- 3. SG Questions: (only let 2 or 3 people answer a specific question for time sake and give everyone a turn)
 - a) Why no consensus on truth?: Read John 14:15–17, Romans 1:18 & Revelation 12:9; Taken from these scriptures why would you say the world is blinded to truth? What is sin and deception?
 - b) Three absolutes of truth: Read John 14, John 17:17 & 1 John 5:6; Which three coordinates (absolutes) of truth must always be present (in agreement) for something to be truth.
 - c) Proclaiming and living the truth: Read 1 Timothy 3:14-15 to 4:1-2 & 2 Timothy 2:24-26: How does God intend to reveal truth to the world primarily?
 - d) Truth in love to our brothers & sisters: Read Galatians 6:1 & Matthew 18:15-16; Which is the right way to bring correction to our brothers when they are found contrary to the truth which excludes judgement?
 - e) True Freedom: John 8:31. What does the truth set us free from? vs the worldly idea of freedom?
- 4. Turn together in groups of 2: Share with one-another how you want to commit to know t he truth in your own life this year. Where there is an area in your life that you want truth to reign confess it to your partner (in confidence) so that God can bring true freedom.
