
Acts 7:58-8:3 (ESV)

Then they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their garments at the feet of a young man named Saul. 


Galatians 1:11-13 (ESV)

For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ. For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it.

Acts 13:1-2 (ESV)

Now there were in the church at Antioch prophets and teachers, Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen a lifelong friend of Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. Acts 14:21-23(ESV)

Weekly small group notes from Sunday Sermon (Duration - 1 to 1.5hrs)

- 1. Welcome: Introduce SG to visitors and ask group to share on the following: Do you have a dream for the Bride of Christ (Church) and what does that look like?
- 2. Worship together: 1 or 2 Worship Songs / open SG in prayer asking the Father to give us His heart for His Church
 - SG Questions: (let 2 or 3 people answer a specific question and give everyone a turn)

 a) a God that leads us: Read Acts 2:17. From this scripture and the fact that God is coming back for a united,
 - pure bride do you think God is wanting to lead His bride through His Spirit?
 b) Void of the Spirit: Read Acts 7:58 to 8:3, Considering that Paul was well versed in the knowledge of
 - scripture why was he persecuting the church?
 - c) Eyes opened to God's heart: Read Acts 9:1-6, Considering that God saw the persecution of the Church by Paul as personal, what should we conclude about God's stance towards His church today?
 - d) Revelation is to build: Read Galatians 1:11-13. When we receive revelation from God that is fresh does that make us indifferent to the church or should we use it to partner with and build the church as God leads? e) A dream for His church. Read Romans 15:20-21. What is your dream/ambition for the church knowing that it is precious to God?
- Turn together in groups of two and ask God if there is any offense in your heart towards His church that He wants you to let go of. Repent of the indifference and commit to Christ that you are available to Him to build His church through your gifting's even if it is tough!
