

Hebrews 10:16-17 (NLT)

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
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**Genesis 6:9–18 (ESV)**


# Exodus 20:1-17 (ESV






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# 1. Freedom From Sin and Bondage

### Weekly small group notes from Sunday Sermon (Duration - 1 to 1.5hrs)

- 1. Welcome: Introduce SG to visitors and ask group to share on the following: Who is the person you have met that you would describe as the most free? Why?
- 2. Worship together: 1 or 2 Worship Songs / open SG in prayer asking the father to show us what Covenant relationship means to him
- 3. ?SG Questions: (let 2 or 3 people answer a specific question and give everyone a turn)
  a) Covenants of old: Read Genesis 6:9-18, Genesis 12:1-7, Exodus 19:3-6 & 1 Kings 9:4-5. Q: What can
  - we find in these scriptures about the people God made covenant with in the old Testament?
  - b) New Covenant from God: Read Hebrews 10:16-17, Matthew 26:27-28. Q: What are the covenant commitments from God towards us in these scriptures?
  - c) Our covenant response: Read Galatians 1:10 & Matthew 10:38-29. Q: Which are two ways of covenant response that we see in the New Testament by followers of Christ. How does this make us free?
- 4. Quote: For us to relate rightly to God we need to know the way of covenant commitment towards Him.

  Spend some time in prayer receiving Gods covenant blessings and committing to follow him as He leads you into deeper covenant faithfulness!
