




## John 15:1-7 (ESV)

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in me that does not bear fruit he takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you. Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is


- Gal. 5:22-23 love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control

## Weekly small group notes from Sunday Sermon (Duration - 1 to 1.5hrs)

- 1. Welcome: Introduce SG to visitors and ask group to share on the following: What do you think it means when God allows pruning in our lives?
- 2. Worship together: 1 or 2 Worship Songs / open SG in prayer asking the father to show us what Covenant relationship means to him
- 3. SG Questions: (let 2 or 3 people answer a specific question and give everyone a turn)
  - The Vine and the branches: Read John 15:1-7 and ask the following questions in the SG:
  - a) Verse 1: What does Jesus imply with the statement "I'm the true (pure, perfect) vine and my father is the vine dresser? (Context for this in statement in Jesus's time can be found in Psalm 80 and Jeremiah 2)
  - b) Verse 2: What does it mean that God prunes every branch that is in Jesus? Does it mean a once off or continual pruning- what would the purpose of pruning be in our lives?
  - c) Verse 4-5: When Jesus says we can do nothing without being routed in Him does it mean we should be ineffective in getting things done as Christians in this world, or does it mean He wants to us to rely on Him to bear much fruit through us as we commit to His purposes?
  - d) Read Matthew 26:28-29: How can we be part and remind ourselves to be part of (routed into) the Vine (Perfect one)?
- 4. Quote: **We can do nothing without Jesus, but with Him we can do exceedingly greater things than before!**Spend some time in prayer meditating on how you can practice "being in Christ" more and more as part of our everyday lives.
