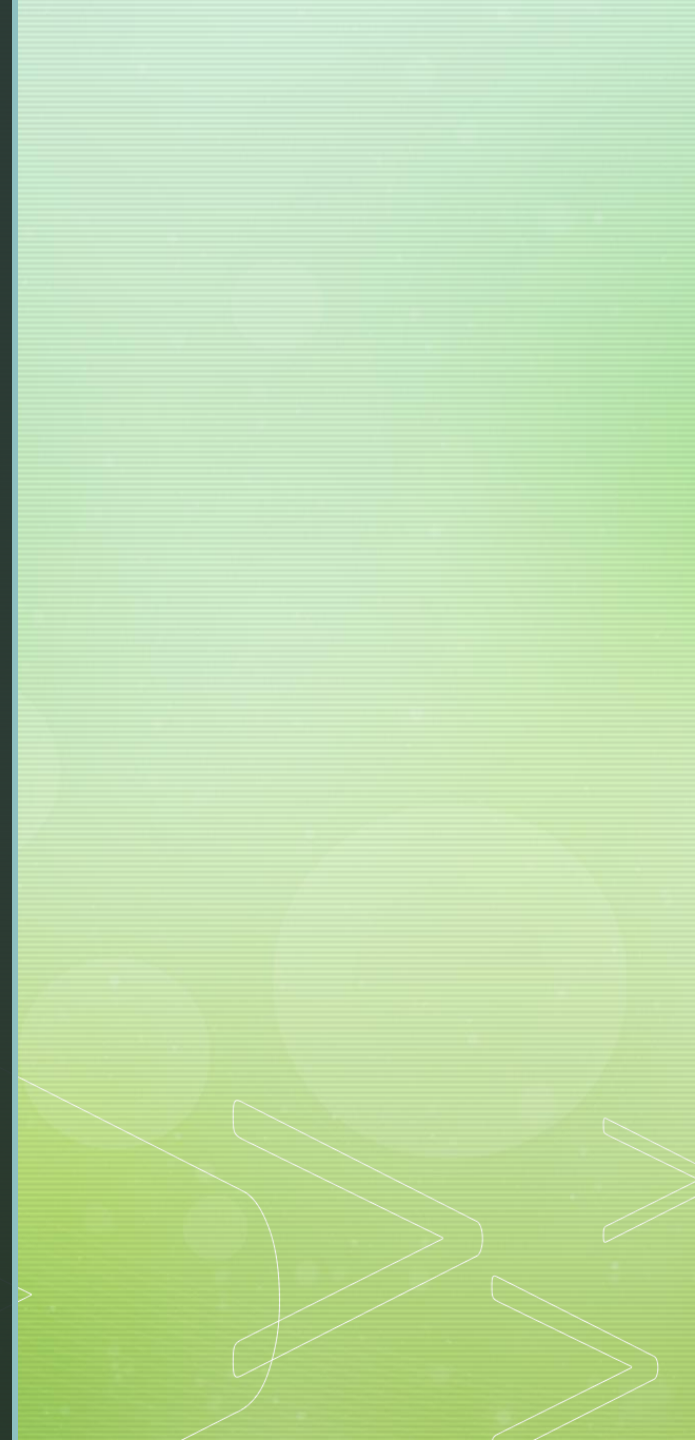


Daily bread



9 Pray then like this:

“Our Father in heaven,

10 Your kingdom come,

but deliver us from evil.



Who is our daily bread?

John 6:25-38: ²⁵ When they found him on the other side of the sea, they said to him, “Rabbi, when did you come here?” ²⁶ Jesus answered them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, you are seeking me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate your fill of the loaves. ²⁷ Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal.” ²⁸ Then they said to him, “What must we do, to be doing the works of God?” ²⁹ Jesus answered them, “This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent.”

³⁰ So they said to him, “Then what sign do you do, that we may see and believe you? What work do you perform? ³¹ Our fathers ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written, ‘He gave them bread from heaven to eat.’” ³² Jesus then said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven, but my Father gives you the true bread from heaven. ³³ For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.” ³⁴ They said to him, “Sir, give us this bread always.”

John 6:38-40: "For I have come down from heaven not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me but raise it up on the last day. For this the will of my Father that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life and I will raise him up on the last day."

Romans 12:16-21: “Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight. Repay no one evil for evil but give thought to do what is honourable in the sight of all. If possible so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God for it is written, Vengeance is mine, I will repay says the Lord. To the contrary if your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty give him something to drink; for by so doing you will heap burning coal on his head. Do not be overcome by evil but overcome evil with good.”

▶ Marks of the true Christian (*eating daily bread*)

Romans 12:9-21: “Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honour. Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord. Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality. Bless those who persecute you, bless and do not curse them. Rejoice with those who rejoice and weep with those who weep.
