Luke Hospitality in Jesus' teaching

10:30-37 Parable of Good Samaritan

11:5-10 Parable of friend with guest.

14:8-11 Teaching of humility/ honour at feast.

14:15-24 Parable of wedding feast.

15:4-32 Parable of lost coin, sheep, son.

16:15-31 Parable of the rich young man and Lazarus.

Hospitality in the early church

Hosting: Simon tanner, God, Peter, the messengers, Cornelius

Acts 9:43-10:48

24 Cornelius was waiting for them, and had called together his relatives and close friends. ...34 Then Peter said: "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality..." 44 While Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word... 48 And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then they asked him to stay a few days.

An invitation into people's hearts


Luke 5:29, 32
