


Isaiah 60:11

Cities of Refuge

- 1. **Kedesh**: to sanctify, set apart, consecrate and therefore to make holy.
- 2. Shechem: between the shoulders or burden bearer.
- 3. Hebron: Joining or fellowship.
- 4. Bezer: signifies a fortified place
- 5. Ramoth: signifying to be high, raised up, exalted.
- 6. Golan: is rejoicing through deliverance.

Leaving the Hiding place





And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.


