Title: honour's reward I

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The Hidden God

Luke 13:35 (NKJV)...I say to you, you shall not see Me <u>until the time</u> comes when <u>you say</u>, 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the LORD!'

- You will not see Me again <u>until you recognize those I send you</u> by declaring,"blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord."
- God has hidden Himself and hidden His rewards. Inside people.
- Every true believe is a temple of the Holy Spirit a residing place for God.

Revealing God

John 13:20 (NKJV) ²⁰ Most assuredly, I say to you, he who receives (honours) whomever I send receives (honours) Me; and he who receives (honours) Me receives (honours) Him who sent Me."

Honour defined

Honour (time – tee mee) speaks of a valuing. Valuable, precious, weighty such as gold.

Dishonour (atimia): to not show respect; to treat <u>as common</u>, <u>ordinary</u>, or menial. Something easily done away with <u>like vapour</u>. [contempt = disrespect]

Honour's reward

Matthew 10:40–42 (NKJV) ⁴⁰ "He who <u>honours you</u> honours Me, and he who honours Me honours Him who sent Me. ⁴¹ He who honours **a prophet** in the name of a prophet shall receive <u>a prophet's reward</u>. And he who honours **a righteous man** in the name of a righteous man shall receive <u>a righteous man's reward</u>. ⁴² And whoever honours one of these **little ones** with only a cup of cold water in the name of a disciple, assuredly, I say to you, he shall <u>by no means lose his reward</u>."

- There is an **authority structure** in the kingdom of God. Everything flows from the Father, to the Son.
- **Next in this order of kingdom** authority is the "prophet". Five-fold ministry. Pastors, prophets, evangelists, teachers, apostles. Each carries a reward.
- Those in authority above us, those on our level, and finally those who are under our care or delegated authority.
- There is a reward if we honour those above us. There is a reward if we honour our peers. There is a reward if we honour those under our authority.
- Each of these three levels carries an amazing reward from heaven.
- *Will we see the Lord? Will we see Jesus at work in our midst? Only when we receive those He sends with honour in our hearts.
- **Honour is never demanded. Honour is given.

Partial reward

Mark 6:3–5 (NKJV) ³ Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us?" So they were offended at Him. ⁴ But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house." ⁵ Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.

• *Jesus could do no mighty work there. Not He didn't want to. They had to value Him to receive it.

- Carriers of God's presence: **The people God has set around us, the vessels God wants to <u>powerfully</u> <u>use</u> to bless us and touch us, <u>we dishonour</u>. We undervalue them.
- It wasn't about the Messenger; it was the way He was received.
- God will often send us what we need, but often in a package we don't want. It takes a bit of humility... & honour.

No reward

Luke 5:17 (NKJV) ¹⁷ Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. <u>And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.</u>

Luke 5:20–21 (NKJV) ²⁰ When <u>He saw their faith</u>, He said to him, "Man, your sins are forgiven you." ²¹ And the scribes and the Pharisees <u>began to reason</u>, saying, "<u>Who is this</u> who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

Matthew 9:3 (NKJV) ³ And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, "This Man blasphemes!"

- Dishonouring in their hearts....
- They received <u>no reward</u>, because they **dishonoured Jesus** <u>merely by the way they thought!</u>
- **True honour flows from the heart.

Full reward

Matthew 8:7–10 (NKJV) ⁷ And Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him." ⁸ The centurion answered and said, "Lord, <u>I am not worthy</u> that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. ⁹ <u>For I also</u> am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." ¹⁰ When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, "Assuredly, I say to you, <u>I have not found such great faith</u>, not even in Israel!

- "I am not worthy" he honoured Jesus!
- I also am under authority he could see that Jesus was a man of authority. Jesus had authority in the spirit realm and so Jesus could merely speak and it will be done.
- Great faith? Honour for Jesus + understanding of authority
