
**Psalm 37:3&4 (Amp)**





“Oversized and rude, fear is unwilling to share the heart with happiness. Happiness complies and leaves. Do you ever see the two together?”



## Matt 14:29-31






**2 Tim 1:7**

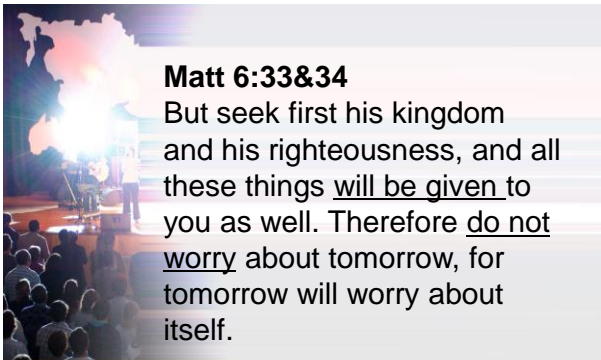
**James 1:6-8**
