Matthew 5:3 (NKJV) ³ "Blessed are **the poor in spirit**, For theirs <u>is the kingdom of heaven</u>.

Beatitudes: *Defining our internal atmosphere or spiritual attitudes.* When this is internalized, then God takes care of the externals.

Blessed are those who do not trust in self, but in God.. blessed are the humble....**Humility is the door to all the resources of heaven. All of heaven available to the poor in spirit.** Pride closes the door. Humility opens the door.

**Focus today: What keeps us from being poor in spirit?

The hypocrite conceals his true motives under a cloak of make-believe.¹

Isaiah 29:13 (NKJV) ¹³ Therefore the Lord said: "Inasmuch as these people draw near with their mouths And honor Me with their lips, But have removed their hearts far from Me...

• God cannot help the hypocrite, but He is drawn to the humble. The hypocrite has placed himself out of God's reach, his heart far removed from God.

Putting up a mask

**Lance Armstrong. He went from legend to leper in almost a day.

His confession to Oprah: "In part one of a two part interview with <u>Oprah Winfrey</u>, aired on January 17, 2013, Armstrong <u>admitted to using performance enhancing drugs</u> throughout much of his career, including all seven Tour de France wins. ^[153] In the interview, Armstrong stated that his "mythic, perfect story" was "one big lie", and attributed his denials to being "a guy who expected to get whatever he wanted, and to control every outcome. ^[154] In part two of the interview, aired the following day, Armstrong said that while doping, he neither felt that it was wrong nor felt bad about what he was doing. ^[157] He further elaborated on doping throughout his career: "My ruthless desire to win at all costs served me well on the bike but the level it went to, for whatever reason, is a flaw. That desire, that attitude, that arrogance." *Wikipedia - Lance Armstrong"

The problem with hypocrisy

Matthew 23:13 (NKJV) ¹³ "But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For **you shut up the kingdom of heaven** against men; for you <u>neither go in yourselves</u>, <u>nor do you allow</u> those who are entering to go in.

Hypocrisy pushes people away from God. Hypocrisy offends God, because it misrepresents Him.

How to unmask the soul?

- 1. Realise you're faking it: (1) Come to God's Word and allow it to speak to you about you. *God's Word is like a mirror, a true mirror. (2) Ask somebody you trust "Do you think I am sometimes fake?"
- 2. **Desire to please God, not man.** When we desire to please man, then we will put on a mask.

- **How do we break the power of pleasing people? (1) Choose to reveal your weaknesses, because your confidence is in God. God cannot help the hypocrite, but God is drawn to the humble. (1b) Don't justify yourself.
- 3. <u>Value the internal, above the external (Don't build your image around temporal things:).</u> <u>Remind yourself continually, the external is secondary, the internal is primary.</u>

Galatians 3:28 (NKJV) ²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are <u>all one</u> in Christ Jesus.

Major issue: *Where is God's glory? When we choose to show our weaknesses, then we open the door for God to be glorified when He does great things through us.

**God cannot help a hypocrite, but He is drawn to the humble.
