Psalm 24:7–10 (NKJV) <sup>7</sup> Lift up your heads, O you gates! And <u>be lifted up</u>, you everlasting doors! <u>And the King of glory</u> <u>shall come in.</u><sup>8</sup> **Who is this King of glory?** The LORD strong and mighty, The LORD mighty in battle.

- Who is He?
- Redemptive names of God: Jehovah Shammah "the Lord is there" / Jehovah Shalom the Lord our peace / Jehovah Ra-ah - the Lord is my shepherd / Jehovah Jireh - the Lord will provide / Jehovah Nissi - the Lord is our Banner or Victor or Captain. / Jehovah Tsidkenu - the Lord our Righteousness. / Jehovah Rapha - "I am the Lord your Physician" or "I am the Lord that heals you".
- He is Lord!!! He is master.

# There can be only One

1 Timothy 1:17 (NLT) <sup>17</sup> <u>All honor</u> and <u>glory</u> to God forever and ever! He is the <u>eternal King</u>, the unseen one who never dies; <u>he alone is God</u>. Amen.

- There can be only One.
- King forever \*\* A throne in our hearts.
- Idolatry blocks the presence of God.
- Idolatry will always lead us outside of the will of God.
- A lie: "God wants me to be happy!" No, He wants you to be holy.

#### God owns you

1 Corinthians 6:18–20 (NKJV) <sup>18</sup> Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality <u>sins against his own body</u>. <sup>19</sup> Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and **you are not your own**? <sup>20</sup> **For you were bought at a price**; therefore <u>glorify God in your body and in your spirit</u>, **which are God's**.

• You are not your own. God owns you. You belong to Him.

John 15:14 (NKJV) <sup>14</sup> You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.

• Friendship with God is reserved for those who obey Him.

### He doesn't owe you anything

Ezekiel 14:2–3 (NKJV)<sup>2</sup> And the word of the LORD came to me, saying, <sup>3</sup> "Son of man, these men <u>have set up their idols</u> in their hearts, and put before them that which <u>causes them to stumble into iniquity</u>. **Should I let Myself be inquired** of at all by them?

- Idols in the heart...
- Idolatry is not limited to calling on a foreign god's name. A form of idolatry is the reduction of God to a lower image; one who will give us what we passionately desire.

Colossians 3:5–7 (NKJV)<sup>5</sup> Therefore <u>put to death your members</u> which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, <u>evil desire</u>, and **covetousness, which is idolatry**. <sup>6</sup> Because of these things the **wrath of God** is coming upon the <u>sons of disobedience</u>, <sup>7</sup> in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them.

- Put to death.
- **Covetousness: Covetousness is the desire for gain.** Covetousness is the state we find ourselves in <u>when</u> <u>we're not content</u>. We strive because we lack peace or rest. Covetousness is to have a strong desire for something that is outside the will of God.

## House of Bondage - idolatry leads to bondage & deception

Exodus 20:2-3 I am the Lord your God, who <u>brought you out of the house of bondage</u>. You shall have **no other gods** <u>before me</u>.

**House of bondage?** When we have idols in our lives then we are led astray. We will find ourselves in bondage. / Anything could become an idol. **\*\*Altar of sacrifice to the idol - we sacrifice everything, we self destruct.** 

# Your will be done - breaking free from idolatry

Matthew 10:37–39 (NKJV) <sup>37</sup> He who loves father or mother more than Me is <u>not worthy of Me</u>. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is <u>not worthy of Me</u>. <sup>38</sup> And he who does **not take his cross and follow after Me** is <u>not</u> <u>worthy of Me</u>. <sup>39</sup> He who **finds his life will lose it**, and he who **loses his life for My sake will find it**.

- loving anything more than God will lead us astray.
- 1. Living loosely. Letting go of good things. \*Don't worship the blessings of God!
- 2. "Your will be done." You break free from idolatry when you choose the will of God over your own.
  - a. What does surrender look like? God even if you <u>never</u> do this, I will still serve you.
- 3. God is everything. Everything else is secondary.
  - a. Making tough decisions : Jesus or the girlfriend? Jesus or the boyfriend? His will be done or yours? Jesus or fleeting pleasure? Every Christian needs to make these decisions.

**Quick test - Who is on the throne?** Passionate about Jesus, his word and seeking his face? Then surely Jesus is on the thrown. But: If you are lukewarm about seeking Jesus, but overly passionate about your hobbies, work, entertainment and other fleshly pursuits? Guess who is on the thrown? Self. Flesh. Not Jesus.

**Seriously.** If self & flesh are enthroned in your heart, and you continue on this path, you could find yourself lost, without Christ, and <u>you don't even realise it</u>.

**God owns you. He owes you nothing. You owe Him everything....** now you are ready for friendship with the King of Glory.
