Walking in covenant

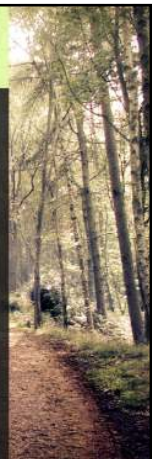
leaping and whirling before the Lord; and she despised him in her heart... therefore Michal the daughter of Saul had no children to the day of her death.”

Walking in covenant

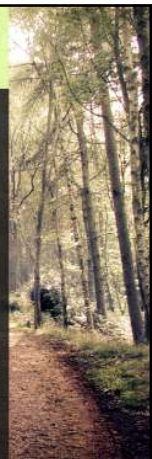
taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men...
