

How do we leave a godly legacy?

1) Leading our children to Christ

1 Samuel 2:12 (NKJV) ¹² *Now the sons of Eli were corrupt; they did not know the LORD.*



2) Ministry begins at home

1 Samuel 2:17 (NKJV) ¹⁷ *Therefore the sin of the young men was very great before the LORD, for men abhorred the offering of the LORD.*

2) Ministry begins at home

1 Samuel 2:18 (NKJV) ¹⁸ *But Samuel ministered before the LORD, **even as a child**, wearing a linen ephod.*

Honour God

1 Samuel 2:29–31 (NKJV) ²⁹ *Why do **you kick** at My sacrifice and My offering which I have commanded in My dwelling place, and **honor your sons more than Me**, to make yourselves fat with the best of all the offerings of Israel My people?' ³⁰*

Honour God

³⁰ *Therefore the LORD God of Israel says: 'I said indeed *that* your house and the house of your father **would walk before Me forever**.' But now the LORD says: 'Far be it from Me; **for those who honor Me I will honor, and those who despise Me shall be lightly esteemed.***

Honour God

³¹ *Behold, the days are coming that I will cut off your arm and the arm of your father's house, so that there will not be an old man in your house.*

3) Bring discipline

Proverbs 13:24 (NKJV) ²⁴ *He who spares his rod **hates his son**, But he **who loves him disciplines him promptly**.*

3) Bring discipline

Proverbs 23:13–14 (NKJV) ¹³ Do not withhold correction from a child, For if you beat him with a rod, he will not die. ¹⁴ You shall beat him with a rod, and deliver his soul from hell.

4) Receive correction

Proverbs 22:15 (NKJV) ¹⁵ Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; **The rod of correction** will drive it far from him.

4) Receive correction

Mission is holiness, not happiness.

Give & Receive correction

*Being **under authority** means I must receive correction.

*Being **in authority** means I must give correction when needed.

Let's be wise!

Proverbs 13:1 (NKJV) ¹ A wise son heeds his father's instruction, But a scoffer does not listen to rebuke.
