Psalm 55:6 (NKJV)

"So I said, oh, that I had wings like a dove! I would fly away and be at rest".

Psalm 55:22 (NKJV)


"Cast your burden on the Lord, and He shall sustain you. He shall never permit the righteous to be shaken."

Practical way of casting your burdens upon the Lord:


1. Speak to Him.

1 Peter 5:7 (AMP)

Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully.



2. Lift up the name of Jesus in worship.
3. Dance before the Lord.
4. Speak to your soul.
Psalm 116:7 (NKJV)
Return to your rest, o my soul, for the Lord has dealt bountifully with you.
5. Have communion.



Why do we need to enter God's rest and stay there?
Isaiah 50:4 (NKJV)
The Lord God has given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to **spea k a word in season to him who is weary**. He awakens me morning by morning. He awakens my ear to hear as the learned."
