**A revivalist**

**Two poisonous lies**

1. You're not a priest and **ONLY** the priest may do ministry.
2. You're not a saint, just a sinner and all the true saints are dead.

**To all the saints**

Philippians 1:1–2 (NKJV) <sup>1</sup> Paul and Timothy, bondservants of Jesus Christ, **To all the saints** in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, with the bishops and deacons: <sup>2</sup> Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

## To all the saints

One of the keys to revival is that **EVERY** believer must realise they are a minister and a priest unto God.

## Where do you stand?

Exodus 33:18–21 (NKJV) <sup>18</sup> And he said, *“Please, show me Your glory.”* <sup>19</sup> Then He said, *“I will make **all My goodness pass before you**, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.”*

## Where do you stand?

<sup>20</sup> But He said, *“You cannot see My face; for no man shall see Me, and live.”* <sup>21</sup> And the LORD said, *“**Here is a place by Me, and you shall stand on the rock.**”*

## The Rock Christ

1 Corinthians 10:1–5 (NKJV) <sup>1</sup> Moreover, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware that **all our fathers were under the cloud, all passed through the sea,** <sup>2</sup> **all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea,** <sup>3</sup> **all ate the same spiritual food,**

## The Rock Christ

<sup>4</sup> and **all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ.** <sup>5</sup> But with most of them God was not well pleased, for their bodies were scattered in the wilderness.
