Hebrews 10:23 (NKJV) <sup>23</sup> Let us hold fast <u>the confession of our hope</u> without wavering, for <u>He who promised</u> is faithful.

# Believe till breakthrough

Romans 4:20-21 *He did not waver at* the promise of God through unbelief, but <u>was strengthened in faith</u>, giving glory to God, and **being fully convinced** that <u>what He had promised</u> <u>He was also able to perform</u>. And therefore **"it was accounted to him for righteousness."** 

## **Believe till breakthrough**

Galatians 3:5–7 (NKJV) <sup>5</sup> Therefore He who **supplies the Spirit to you** and **works miracles among you**, does He do it by the works of the law, or <u>by the</u> <u>hearing of faith</u>? <sup>6</sup> just as Abraham "believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." <sup>7</sup> Therefore know that **only those who are of faith** <u>are sons</u> of Abraham.

2 Corinthians 1:20 (NKJV) <sup>20</sup> For <u>all the</u> <u>promises of God</u> **in Him** are Yes, and **in Him** Amen, to the glory of God through us.

John 4:35 (NKJV) <sup>35</sup> **Do you not say**, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, **I say to you**, <u>lift up your eyes and look at the</u> <u>fields</u>, for they **are** <u>already</u> white for harvest!

John 4:6<sup>6</sup> Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

John 4:17–19 (NKJV) <sup>17</sup> The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband,' <sup>18</sup> for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband; in that you spoke truly." <sup>19</sup> The woman said to Him, "Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet.

Mark 5:5-8 <sup>5</sup> And always, night and day, he was in the mountains and in the tombs, crying out and cutting himself with stones. <sup>6</sup> When **he saw** Jesus from afar, **he ran and worshiped Him**.

<sup>7</sup> And he cried out with a loud voice and said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, **Son of the Most High God**? I implore You by God that **You do not torment me**." <sup>8</sup> For He said to him, "Come out of the man, unclean spirit!"

## Known in hell

Acts 19:15-16 <sup>15</sup> And the evil spirit answered and said, "Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but <u>who</u> are you?" <sup>16</sup> Then the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

Acts 8:4–8 (NKJV) <sup>4</sup> Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere **preaching the word**. <sup>5</sup> Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and **preached Christ to them**. <sup>6</sup> And <u>the</u> <u>multitudes with one accord heeded the</u> <u>things spoken</u> by Philip, **hearing and seeing the miracles which he did**.

<sup>7</sup> For unclean spirits, crying **with a loud voice**, came out of <u>many who were</u> <u>possessed</u>; and **many** who were paralyzed and lame were healed. <sup>8</sup> And there was **great joy** in that city.
