**WHO CAN THIS BE?**

Mark 4:37–41 (NKJV) <sup>37</sup> *And a great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling. <sup>38</sup> But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow. And they awoke Him and said to Him,*

*“Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?” <sup>39</sup> Then He **arose and rebuked the wind**, and said to the sea, **“Peace, be still!”** And the wind ceased and there was a great calm. <sup>40</sup> But He said to them,*

**WHO CAN THIS BE?**

*“Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?” <sup>41</sup> And they feared exceedingly, and said to one another, **“Who can this be, that even the wind and the sea obey Him!”***

### MASSIVE STORM

1 Samuel 17:11 (NKJV) <sup>11</sup> *When Saul and all Israel heard these words of the Philistine, they were **dismayed and greatly afraid.***  
1 Samuel 17:24 (NKJV) <sup>24</sup> *And all the men of Israel, when they saw the man, **fled from him and were dreadfully afraid.***

### MASSIVE STORM

1 Samuel 17:26 (NKJV) <sup>26</sup> *Then David spoke to the men who stood by him, saying, "What shall be done for the man who kills this Philistine and takes away the reproach from Israel?"*

### MASSIVE STORM

*For who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should **defy the armies of the living God?**"*

### STORM?

You're not alone  
Whoever comes against you,  
comes against God Himself.

**See Him!**

1 Samuel 17:40 (NKJV) <sup>40</sup> Then he took his *staff in his hand*; and he chose **for himself five smooth stones** from the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine.

**Prophecy!**

1 Samuel 17:42–46 (NKJV) <sup>42</sup> And when the Philistine looked about and saw David, **he *disdained him***; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good-looking. <sup>43</sup> So the Philistine said to David, “Am I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?”

**Prophecy!**

And the Philistine **cursed David by his gods.** <sup>44</sup> And the Philistine said to David, “Come to me, and I will give your flesh to the birds of the air and the beasts of the field!” <sup>45</sup> Then David said to the Philistine, “You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a

javelin. **But I come to you in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied.** <sup>46</sup> **This day the LORD will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you and take your head from you.**

**Prophecy!**

And **this day I will give the carcasses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of the air and the wild beasts of the earth, **that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel.****

**Victory!**

1 Samuel 17:50 (NKJV) <sup>50</sup> So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone, and struck the Philistine and killed him.
