# **Family**

Ephesians 2:18 - 22 (NLT) <sup>18</sup> Now all of us can come to the Father through the same Holy Spirit because of what Christ has done for us. <sup>19</sup> So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people.

## **Family**

You are members of God's family.

20 Together, we are his house, built on the foundation of the apostles and the prophets. And the cornerstone is Christ Jesus himself. 21 We are carefully joined together in him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord.

<sup>22</sup> Through him you Gentiles are also being made part of this dwelling where God lives by his Spirit.

### No longer strangers

Ephesians 2:19–22 (NLT) <sup>19</sup> So <u>now</u> you Gentiles are <u>no longer</u> strangers and foreigners. You are <u>citizens</u> along with **all of God's holy people**. You are **members of God's family.** <sup>20</sup> **Together**, we are <u>his house</u>

#### **Built on the Foundation**

#### **Built on the Foundation**

Acts 2:41–42 (The Message) <sup>41</sup>
That day about three thousand took him at his word, were baptized and were signed up. <sup>42</sup>
They <u>committed themselves</u> to the teaching of the apostles, the <u>life</u> <u>together</u>, the <u>common meal</u>, and the prayers.

#### **Built on the Foundation**

Fellowship (life together), koinonia (koy-nohn-ee-ah); Sharing, unity, close association, partnership, participation, a communion, a fellowship, contributory help, the brotherhood. Koinonia is a unity brought about by the Holy Spirit.

#### **Built on the Foundation**

In koinonia the individual shares in common an intimate bond of fellowship with the rest of the Christian society. Koinonia cements the believers to the Lord Jesus and to each other.
