Exodus 3:10–12 (NKJV) <sup>10</sup> **Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt.**"

Matthew 21:1–9 (NKJV) <sup>1</sup> Now when they drew near Jerusalem, and came to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, <sup>2</sup> saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you

**will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Loose them and bring them to Me.** <sup>3</sup> And if anyone says anything to you, you shall say, '**The Lord has need of them,**' and immediately he will send them."

Matthew 21:4-5 (NKJV) <sup>4</sup> All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: <sup>5</sup> "Tell the daughter of Zion, '**Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.**' "

## DONKEYS?

Matthew 21:6-9 (NKJV) *So the disciples went and did as Jesus commanded them. <sup>7</sup> They brought the donkey and the colt, laid their clothes on them, and set Him on them. <sup>8</sup> And a very great multitude spread their clothes on the road;*

## DONKEYS?

*others cut down branches from the trees and spread them on the road. <sup>9</sup> Then the multitudes who went before and those who followed cried out, saying: "Hosanna to the Son of David! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!'*

## DONKEYS?

*Hosanna in the highest!" <sup>10</sup> And when He had come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, "Who is this?" <sup>11</sup> So the multitudes said, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee."*

Jeremiah 2:11–13 (NKJV) <sup>11</sup> *Has a nation changed its gods, which are not gods? **But My people have changed their Glory For what does not profit.** <sup>12</sup> **Be astonished, O heavens, at this, And be horribly afraid; Be very desolate,**" says the LORD.*
