


Building Bridges



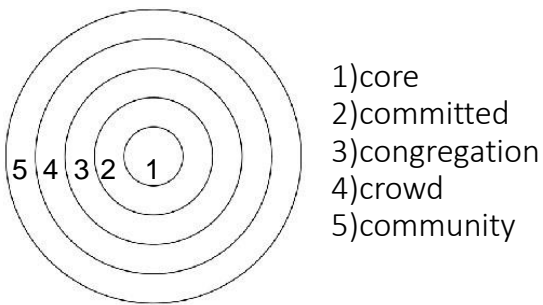
- (Joh 3:16) "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

(Mat 28:20) teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

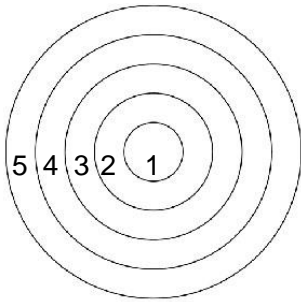



The 4P's of evangelism


1) Pursue Friendship

- (Joh 1:14) And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.






3) Partnership evangelism
