Deuteronomy 6:5-7 NKJV

"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart.

DILIGENCE

You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down and when you rise up."

DILIGENCE

Our first responsibility: To love the Lord with all our heart, soul and strength.

Our goal is not to make our children dependent on us, but **dependent on God**.

FAITH AND PATIENCE

BEING REAL

Romans 12:9a NKJV

"Let love be without hypocrisy..."

BEING REAL

Proverbs 22:6 NKJV
