**a. Freedom**

**Freedom - defined**

- state of being free
- exemption from external control
- special rights of citizenship
- acting without compulsion

**b. Destined for freedom**

**Luke 4:18-19**

<sup>18</sup> “ The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; <sup>19</sup> To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.”

**John 8:36 (NIV)**

**c. The road the Emmaus**

**Luke 24:13-35**

- Jesus opens our eyes.
- truth is Jesus
- Jesus makes our hearts burn

<sup>16</sup> but they were kept from recognizing him.

<sup>21</sup> but we had hoped that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel.

<sup>31</sup> Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him, and he disappeared from their sight. <sup>32</sup> They asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

**d. Joy of your salvation**

**Isaiah 12:2-4**

<sup>2</sup> Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The LORD, the LORD, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation.” <sup>3</sup> With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation. <sup>4</sup> In that day you will say: "Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done, and proclaim that his name is exalted.
