Also called "Songs of Ascent"

Sung during Israelites journeys to Jerusalem.

**b: our pilgrimage, our destination**

**Hebrews 12:1-2**

<sup>1</sup> Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, <sup>2</sup> looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

<sup>1</sup> I was glad when they said to me, "Let us go into the house of the LORD."<sup>2</sup> Our feet have been standing Within your gates, O Jerusalem!<sup>3</sup> Jerusalem is built As a city that is compact together,<sup>4</sup> Where the tribes go up, The tribes of the LORD, To the Testimony of Israel, To give thanks to the name of the LORD.

**e: "As the mountains surround Jerusalem..."**

The hills around Jerusalem

1. Mnt Moriah (*marah*) : presence of the Lord
2. Mnt Bethsaida (*chesed*): mercy of the Lord
3. Mnt Scopus: a place of healing
4. Mnt Olive (*zatim*): passionate intensity in bringing new life.
5. Mnt Opel: to build up and to surround with a wall.
6. Mnt Zion (*Tziyyon*): a stonghold and fortress
7. Mnt Chareb (*calvary*): place of sacrifice.
