•	HOW ENTITLEMENT MANIFESTS IN US The depth or duration of our devotion to God can earn us certain benefits o "I had been serving God for so many years, and still" Horatio Spafford – 'It is well with my soul'	
•	HOW ENTITLEMENT MANIFESTS IN US Offense Unforgiveness Resentment Bitterness Rooted in pride The fruit is a hardened heart	
•	HOW ENTITLEMENT MANIFESTS IN US An unthankful heart o "I am rightfully due so why should I be thankful" o "It is a result of my hard work / personal efforts, so it is a fair reward"	

How entitlement manifests in us An inability to receive Giving and receiving becomes transactional Difficult to receive something that has not been earned, to receive based purely on the giver's goodness	
No evidence of a servant's heart What I can get vs. what I can give Expect to be served vs. to serve Lust vs. love Claiming your vows vs. fulfilling mine
