	THE NAZARITE VOW  11The priest will offer one of the birds for a sin offering and the other for a burnt offering. In this way, he will purify them from the guilt they incurred through contact	
	with the dead body. Then they must reaffirm their commitment and let their hair begin to grow again. <sup>12</sup> The days of their vow that were completed before their defilement no longer	
	count.

	Nazirites, they must each go to the entrance of the Tabernacle <sup>14</sup> and offer their sacrifices	
	to the LORD: a one-year-old male lamb without defect for a burnt offering, a one-	
	year-old female lamb without defect for a sin offering, a ram without defect for a peace

The priest must also present the prescribed grain offering and liquid

THE NAZARITE VOW  18"Then the Nazirites will shave their heads at the entrance of the Tabernacle. They will take the hair that had been dedicated and place it

basket a cake and a wafer made without yeast. He will put them all into the Nazirite's hands.	-
