- eusebeia
- yoo-seb'-i-ah
- *piety*; specifically the *gospel* scheme: godliness, holiness.
- In the Greek language means: piety or holiness
- The things of the Lord
- The things of the Kingdom of God
- A life dedicated and surrender to the Lord
- A life in service of the Lord!
