**A: Who's your daddy?**

**Matthew 6:9**

<sup>9</sup>In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

<sup>1</sup>Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, <sup>2</sup>for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. <sup>3</sup>For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, <sup>4</sup>who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

**C: Passionate persistence**

**Matthew 6:11**

<sup>11</sup>Give us this day our daily bread.

**Luke 11:3**

<sup>3</sup>Give us day by day our daily bread.

**Psalms 55:17**

<sup>17</sup>Evening and morning and at noon I will pray, and cry aloud, And He shall hear my voice.

**Luke 18:1,7-8**

<sup>1</sup>Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart, <sup>7</sup>And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? <sup>8</sup>I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"

**Matthew 6:12**

<sup>12</sup>And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors.

**2 Chronicles 7:14**

<sup>14</sup>If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

**Matthew 5:44**

<sup>44</sup>But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,

**E: Maintaining focus**

**Matthew 6:13a**

<sup>13a</sup>And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one.

**Matthew 26:41**

<sup>41</sup>Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

**Romans 8:26,27**

<sup>26</sup>Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

<sup>27</sup>Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

**F: The Father's glory**

**Matthew 6:13b**

<sup>13b</sup>For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

**Revelation 8:3-5**

<sup>3</sup>Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. <sup>4</sup>And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand. <sup>5</sup>Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw it to the earth. And there were noises, thunderings, lightnings, and an earthquake.
