### Hebrews 4:1-12

¹Therefore, since a promise remains of entering into His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it. ²For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well to as to them; but the Word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it. ³For we who have believed do enter that rest...¹There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. ¹ºFor he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His. ¹¹Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience. ¹²For the Word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and joints and marrow and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

## Katapauo/sis – hebr.

- To settle down, to cease, to rest, to give rain
- Rest also means freedom from whatever worries or disturbs you. Some people cannot rest mentally and
  emotionally because they are so easily annoyed. Every little nuisance upsets them and they always feel
  hassled. Rest does not mean freedom from all nuisances and hassles; it means freedom from being so
  easily bothered by them.
