Three pillars of a nation

- Education
- Government / Politic
- Business

Marketplace is the heart (pillars) of the nation. To change a nation you need to change the heart.

"Holy" problem

- "Werk vs Kerk"- Work & Church
- "Sunday Christian" phenomenon
- God anoints the Pastor but not the "Professional"

Deadly lies

- God ordained separation: church servant & marketplace ministers.
- The Church of God functions on Sundays and specifically in Buildings.
- Christians in the Marketplace are not as spiritual as those in Church.
- The primary role of businesspeople are to make money to fund church and missions etc.

Interesting situations – the Word

Mark 6:2-3

²The next Sabbath He began teaching in the synagogue, and many who heard him were amazed. They asked, "Where did he get all this wisdom and the power to perform such miracles?" ³Then they scoffed, "He's just a carpenter, the son of Mary and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas, and Simon. And his sisters live right here among us." They were deeply offended and refused to believe in him.

- Matt Retired tax collector
- Luke Medical Doctor
- John Fisherman
- Mark –Relative of wealthy Barnabas & son of Mary, last supper room.
- Paul fund missions business (Acts 20:33-35)
- 22 miracles = 1 in religious environment.
- First Church Upper room: 120 + stayed.

- Freed from prison: Acts 5:17-20
- Impacted the most powerful forum Jerusalem(Sanhedrin): Acts 5:33-39
- Thousands led to God: Acts 6:7 And the Word increased and the number of disciples multiplied.
- Jerusalem transformed in the deepest level = needs of the widows and poor met: Acts 6:1-7.
