





(Joh 7:38) Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.'"




# 3 Things He teaches His sons and daughters

1) He teaches us who we are





**2) Growing because I am accepted**




2) He inspires us unto a purpose



(Php 3:12) Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own.

(Php 3:13) Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead,



(Php 3:14) I press on toward the goal  
for the prize of the upward call of God in  
Christ Jesus.



2) He inspires us unto a purpose


The contrast:
