





# Unpacking Intercession

– “*PAGA*”, the Hebrew for intercession means to meet.

Jesus is *the* intercessor: On the cross “*PAGA*” *happened*.

# Unpacking Intercession

The “*PAGA*” at the cross

- Mercy met judgement
- Righteousness met sin
- Love met hate
- “A cursed one on a tree met the curse that originated from a tree”

# 1) We distribute what Jesus produced

- (Joh 20:21) Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you."

# 1) We distribute what Jesus produced

- The producer wants to distribute through us
- The healer wants to heal through us
- The life changer wants to change lives through us
- The forgiver wants to forgive through us



## 2) We violently “*paga*” to “break/stop/end”

(Col 2:15) He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

## 2) We violently “paga” to “break/stop/end”

- (1Jn 3:8) Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.

## 2) We violently “paga” to “break/stop/end”

- (Psa 3:7) Arise, O LORD! Save me,  
O my God! For you strike all my  
enemies on the cheek; you break the  
teeth of the wicked.



## 2) We violently “paga” to “break/stop/end”

- (Luk 10:19) Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.

## 2) We violently “paga” to “break/stop/end”

- *LUO*: to dissolve a void contract or to announce that someone is no longer bound

## 2) We violently “paga” to “break/stop/end”

- (Rom 16:20) The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you.





## 2) We violently “paga” to “break/stop/end”

– “satan, we bind this plan of yours to  
take Jack’s life. It will not succeed”

### **3) We lovingly “paga” to bind/bleess/declare/distribute**

- In this part of intercession we pray  
Gods goodness/provision into the  
situation with faith

### **3) We lovingly “paga” to bind/bleess/declare/distribute**

- The producer wants to distribute through us

### **3) We lovingly “paga” to bind/bless/declare/distribute**

- (Eph 1:2) Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- (Col 1:2) To the saints and faithful brothers in Christ at Colossae: Grace to you and peace from God our Father.
