What is apostolic anyway?

(Rom 1:1) Paul, a **servant** of Christ Jesus, **called** to be an **apostle**, **set apart** for the gospel of God,

# Saved to be “set apart”

- (Eph 2:4) But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us,
- (Eph 2:5) even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—

# Saved to be “set apart”


- (Eph 2:10) For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.



# You are set apart for Jesus

By grace He called you and washed your sin away. So that you may leave your “works” to be His workmanship.

You are set apart for His Kingdom.



Latin: “missio” where we got the word: missionary.



- (Rom 1:17) For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."


# These two things
