- (Tit 2:1) But as for you, teach what accords with sound doctrine.
- (Tit 2:2) Older men are to be sober-minded, dignified, **self-controlled**, sound in faith, in love, and in steadfastness.
- (Tit 2:3) Older women likewise are to be reverent in behaviour, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good,

- (Tit 2:10) not pilfering, but showing all good faith, so that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour.

  - (Tit 2:14) who gave himself for us to redeem us from **all lawlessness** and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.
