# Small Group: not an end in itself

- Fellowship with believers.
- Growing together with believers.
- Loving other people.
- Sharing and receiving with others.
- Caring on a personal level

These are commands. Small group helps us to be faithful to the command of “fellowship”





# Baptised into one body

- (1Co 12:12) For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ.
- (1Co 12:13) For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.





# Baptised into one body

- (1Co 12:14) For the body does not consist of one member but of many.
- (1Co 12:15) If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body.



# Baptised into one body

- (1Co 12:13) For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.
- (1Co 12:27) Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.





# Jesus leads the body as the head

- (Col 1:17) And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together.
- (Col 1:18) And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent.

# You grow in the body

- (Eph 4:15) Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ,
- (Eph 4:16) from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love.



# You grow in the body

- (Heb 10:24) And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,
- (Heb 10:25) not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.





- Unity is easy if you don't care about holiness. Holiness is quite easy if you don't care about community. It's doing the two of them together that's the real trick. (NT Wright). Let's face it.
