





• : an area where most people have the same beliefs, values, etc. : an area dominated by a particular group


 : a protected place where the members of a military group stay and can defend themselves against attacks

#### "Your-Dictionary"

 (Neh 1:4) As soon as I heard these words I sat down and wept and mourned for days, and I continued fasting and praying before the God of heaven.

#### The "Stronghold" of Jerusalem


 (Neh 4:3) Tobiah the Ammonite was beside him, and he said, "Yes, what they are building—if a fox goes up on it he will break down their stone wall!"

• (Neh 4:6) So we built the wall. And all the wall was joined together to half its height, for the people had a mind to work.
