Deut 34:5-12

- (Deu 34:5) So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD,
- (Deu 34:6) and he buried him in the valley in the land of Moab opposite Beth-peor; but no one knows the place of his burial to this day.



Deut 34:5-12

- (Deu 34:7) Moses was 120 years old when he died. His eye was undimmed, and his vigor unabated.
- (Deu 34:8) And the people of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days. Then the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

- (Deu 34:9) And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him. So the people of Israel obeyed him and did as the LORD had commanded Moses.
- (Deu 34:10) And there has not arisen a prophet since in Israel like Moses, whom the LORD knew face to face,



Deut 34:5-12

- (Deu 34:11) none like him for all the signs and the wonders that the LORD sent him to do in the land of Egypt, to Pharaoh and to all his servants and to all his land,
- (Deu 34:12) and for all the mighty power and all the great deeds of terror that Moses did in the sight of all Israel.



Joshua 1:1-6

- (Jos 1:1) After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, the LORD said to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant,
- (Jos 1:2) "Moses my servant is dead. Now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the people of Israel.



Joshua 1:1-6

- (Jos 1:3) Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given to you, just as I promised to Moses.
- (Jos 1:4) From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun shall be your territory.



Joshua 1:1-6

- (Jos 1:5) No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you or forsake you.
- (Jos 1:6) Be strong and courageous, for you shall cause this people to inherit the land that I swore to their fathers to give them.
