1) The devil's temptation

Matthew 4:3-9

³Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, **%** You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.+⁴ But He answered and said, **%** is written, **±**Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.q⁺⁵ Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, ⁶ and said to Him, **%** You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down. For it is written: **±**He shall give His angels charge over you,qand, **±**n *their* hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.q

⁷ Jesus said to him, % is written again, \pm You shall not tempt the Lord your God.q-⁸ Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. ⁹ And he said to Him, %II these things <u>I will give</u> You if You will fall down and worship me.+
