Romans 12:10 (NLT) Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honouring each other.

Definition of Honour

Greek = time (say it "tee-may")

Means - to value or to treat as valuable other def:

"appreciation, esteem, favourable, respect, regard.

Philippians 2:6 (NLT) Though he was God, he did not demand and cling to his rights as God.

1 Peter 2:17 Honour all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king

Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Galatians 4:13-14 ¹³ Surely you remember that I was sick when I first brought you the Good News of Christ. ¹⁴ But even though my sickness was revolting to you, you did not reject me and turn me away. No, you took me in and cared for me as though I were an angel from God or even Christ Jesus himself.

Philippians 2:4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.
