**Romans 12:10 (NLT)** Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honouring each other.

## Definition of Honour

**Greek = time (say it “tee-may”)**

Means - to value or to treat as valuable

other def:

“appreciation, esteem, favourable, respect, regard.

**Philippians 2:6 (NLT)** Though he was God, he did not demand and cling to his rights as God.

**1 Peter 2:17** Honour all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king

**Romans 5:8** But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**Galatians 4:13-14** <sup>13</sup> Surely you remember that I was sick when I first brought you the Good News of Christ. <sup>14</sup> But even though my sickness was revolting to you, you did not reject me and turn me away. No, you took me in and cared for me as though I were an angel from God or even Christ Jesus himself.

**Philippians 2:4** Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

**Mark 10: 45** “For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many”

**Philippians 2:7** But made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness”

**Philippians 2:3** Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves.

**Romans 12:10 (NIV)** Honour one another above yourselves

**Romans 12:10 (ESV)** Outdo one another in showing honour.

**Outdo means:**

- to do it with eagerness,
- to take the lead
- not to hold back.

**Psalms 8:3 – 5 (CEV)** <sup>3</sup> I often think of the heavens your hands have made, and of the moon and stars you put in place. <sup>4</sup> Then I ask, "Why do you care about us humans? Why are you concerned for us weaklings?" <sup>5</sup> You made us a little lower than you yourself, and you have crowned us with glory and honour.
