2 Timothy 1:7 (NIV) For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

For God has not given us a spirit of intimidation, but gives us the power to choose love, which will lead to a sound mind.

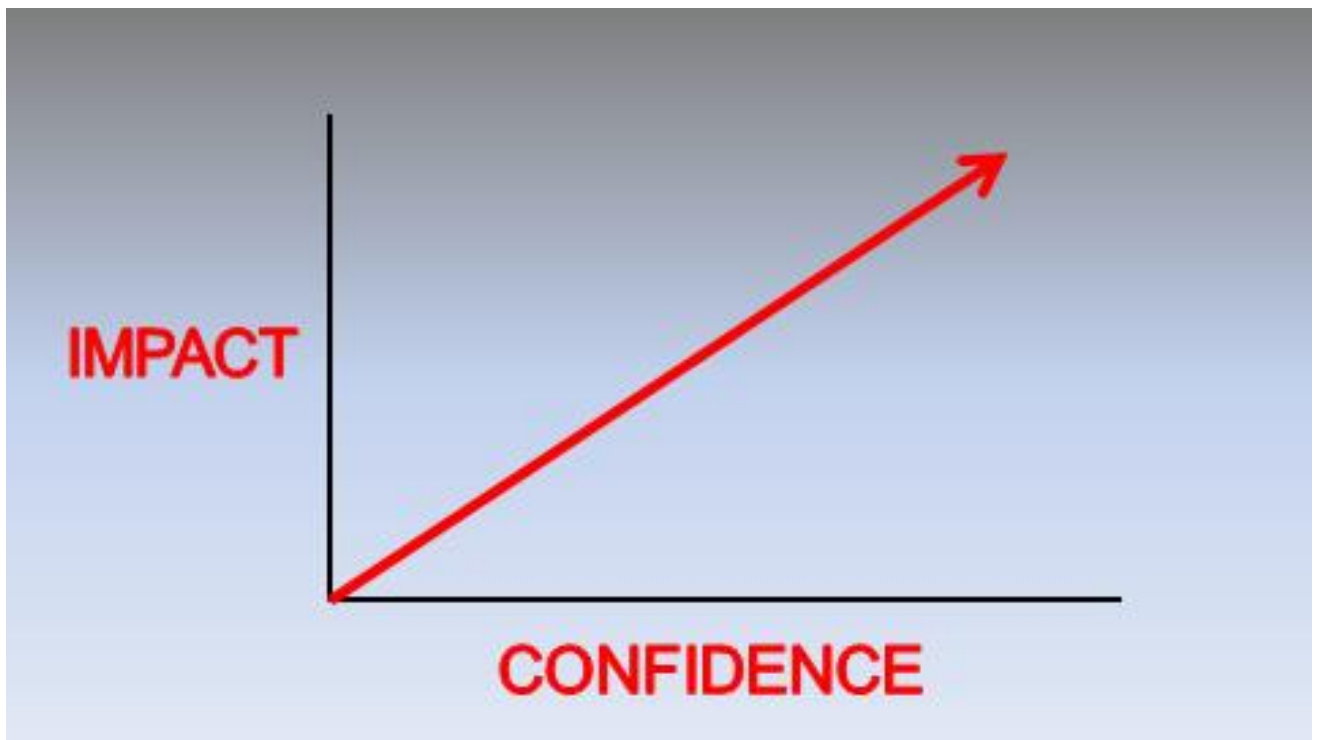
1. Equip yourself
