Matthew 24:10, 12-14 (NKJV) ¹⁰ And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. ¹² And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. ¹³ But he who endures to the end shall be saved. ¹⁴ And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

- 3. TODAY YOU WILL BE WITH ME IN PARADISE

1. FATHER FORGIVE THEM

Luke 23:34 And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."

John 20:23 If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you withhold forgiveness from any, it is withheld."

Luke 6:37 forgive, and you will be forgiven;

Colossians 2:13 if one has a complaint against another, <u>forgiving each other</u>; as the Lord has <u>forgiven you</u>, <u>so you also must forgive</u>.

Ephesians 4:31-32 ³¹ Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. ³² Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, <u>forgiving one another</u>, <u>as God in Christ forgave you</u>.



2. WE ARE FAMILY

John 19:26-27 ²⁶ When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "Woman, <u>behold, your son!</u>" ²⁷ Then he said to the disciple, "<u>Behold, your mother!</u>" And from that hour the disciple took her <u>to his own home</u>.

Hebrews 10:24-25 ²⁴ And let us consider how to <u>stir up one another to love and good works</u>, ²⁵ not neglecting to <u>meet together</u>, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

Galatians 5:13-14 ¹³ For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but <u>through love serve one another</u>. ¹⁴ For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "<u>You shall love your neighbour</u> as yourself."

Galatians 6:9-10 9 And <u>let us not grow weary of doing good</u>, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. ¹⁰ So then, as we have opportunity, <u>let us do good to everyone</u>, and <u>especially</u> to those who are of the <u>household of faith</u>.

Romans 12 ⁹ Let <u>love be genuine</u>. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. ¹⁰ <u>Love one another with brotherly affection</u>. Outdo one another in showing honour. 11 Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the <u>Lord</u>. ¹² Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be <u>constant in prayer</u>. ¹³ <u>Contribute to the needs of the saints</u> and seek to show <u>hospitality</u>. ¹⁴ Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them. ¹⁵ Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. ¹⁶ <u>Live in harmony with one another</u>. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight. ¹⁷ Repay no one evil for evil, but give thought to do what is honourable in the sight of all. ¹⁸ If possible, so far as it depends on you, <u>live peaceably with all</u>. ¹⁹ Beloved, <u>never avenge yourselves</u>, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord." ²⁰ To the contrary, "<u>if your enemy is hungry, feed him</u>; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink; for by so doing you will heap burning coals on his head." ²¹ Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

3. THE LOST

Luke 23:43 And he said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

John 17:18 As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world.

Mark 16:15 And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation."

Mark 16:20 And they went out and <u>preached everywhere</u>, while the <u>Lord worked with them</u> and <u>confirmed the message</u> by accompanying signs.
