The Spirit of the Lord

Isaiah 61:1

¹ The <u>Spirit of the Lord</u> GOD is upon me, because the LORD has <u>anointed</u> me <u>to bring</u> good news to the poor; he has <u>sent me</u> to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor,

Isaiah 61:2-3

² and the day of <u>vengeance</u> of our God; to <u>comfort</u> all who mourn; ³ to grant to those who mourn in Zion-to <u>give them</u> a beautiful headdress instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit; that they may be <u>called oaks of righteousness</u>, the planting of the LORD, that he may be glorified.

Isaiah 61:4

⁴ They shall <u>build up</u> the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former devastations; they shall <u>repair</u> the ruined cities, the <u>devastations of many generations</u>.

Isaiah 61:5

⁵ Strangers shall stand and tend your flocks; foreigners shall be your plowmen and vinedressers;

Priests of the LORD

Isaiah 61:6

⁶ but you shall be called the <u>priests of the LORD</u>; they shall speak of you as the ministers of our God; you shall eat the wealth of the nations, and in their glory you shall boast.

God restores us

Isaiah 61:7

⁷ Instead of your shame there shall be a <u>double portion</u>; instead of dishonor they shall <u>rejoice</u> in their lot; therefore in their land they shall possess a double portion; they shall have <u>everlasting joy</u>.

God made an Everlasting Covenant

Isaiah 61:8

⁸ For I the LORD love justice; I hate robbery and wrong; I will faithfully give them their <u>recompense</u>, and I will make an <u>everlasting covenant</u> with them.

Our descendants will be blessed

Isaiah 61:9

⁹ Their offspring shall be known among the nations, and their descendants in the midst of the peoples; all who see them shall acknowledge them, that they are an offspring the LORD has blessed.

Rejoice because we are saved

Isaiah 61:10

¹⁰ I will greatly rejoice in the LORD; my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of <u>salvation</u>; he has covered me with the robe of <u>righteousness</u>, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with a beautiful headdress, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

Isaiah 61:11

¹¹ For as the earth brings forth its sprouts, and as a garden causes what is sown in it to sprout up, so the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to sprout up <u>before all the nations</u>.

Romans 10:13-15

¹³ For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." ¹⁴ How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? ¹⁰ Go through, go through the gates; prepare the way for the people; build up, build up the highway; clear it of stones; lift up a signal over the peoples. ¹¹ Behold, the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the earth: Say to the daughter of Zion, "Behold, your salvation comes; behold, his reward is with him, and his recompense before him." ¹² And they shall be called The Holy People, The Redeemed of the LORD; and you shall be called Sought Out, A City Not Forsaken.
