Matthew 19:7-9

7 They said to him, "Why then did Moses" command one to give a certificate of divorce and to send her away?" 8 He said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart Moses allowed you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so. And I say to you: whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery."

Genesis 1:26

Then God said, "Let <u>us</u> <u>make man in our</u> <u>image</u>, after <u>our likeness</u>. And let them have <u>dominion</u> over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

Genesis 2:15

Genesis 2:18
Then the LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; <u>I will make him a helper fit for him</u>."

God decided who Adam had to marry



Genesis 2:20

The man gave names to all livestock and to the birds of the heavens and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper fit for him.

God prepared the woman for the man



Genesis 2:21
So the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and while he slept took one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh.

God presented the woman to the man



Genesis 2:22 And the rib that the LORD God had taken from the man <u>he made into a woman</u> and <u>brought</u> her to the man.





Genesis 2:23-24

Then the man said, "This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." 24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.





Genesis 2:25 And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.





Matthew 18:19

Ephesians 2:8-10
